Pre-Evacuation Alert

HOUSE PREPARATION CHECKLIST (only <u>IF</u> time allows and there is no evacuation order)

- ✓ Close all windows and doors and leave unlocked
- ✓ Remove flammable curtains (stow shades in fully closed position)
- ✓ Move furniture to center of rooms away from windows
- ✓ Turn and leave on interior and exterior lights
- ✓ Turn off furnace and water heater
- ✓ Turn off gas/propane to house
- ✓ Bring deck cushions, door mats, and other flammable items inside
- ✓ Set out go bags
- ✔ Gather prescription medications
- ✓ Prepare pet carriers, including food, water, and meds
- ✓ Prepare the "stuff to take" list and load items in preferred vehicle
- Ensure gas tanks are full
- ✓ Park vehicle pointed down the driveway
- ✓ Tag horses and other large animals
